Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:45pm

New Cases

Sunday, December 13, 2020 – fifty two new cases admitted, plus four residential cases at a correctional facility

The Cayuga County Health Department received confirmation of recent deaths related to COVID-19. Three Cayuga County residents who had tested positive for COVID-19 and were hospitalized, have passed away. The decedents, a female in her eighties, a male in his eighties and a female in her sixties, had been hospitalized for complications related to COVID-19. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.
