New Cases

Monday, January 18, 2021 – an observed holiday for staff, therefore two new cases were admitted

Two Cayuga County nursing home residents, both females in their 80's had tested positive for COVID-19 and have passed away. One Cayuga County nursing home resident, a female in her 70's had tested positive for COVID-19, was hospitalized and has passed away. Two Cayuga County residents, a male in his 60's and a male in his 80's had tested positive for COVID-19, were hospitalized and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and their families, we will not be releasing further information.
