New Cases

Monday, April 19, 2021 – nine new cases completed

There have been 5,810 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Hospitalizations

Today there are five COVID-19 related hospitalizations at Auburn Community Hospital.

Deaths

There have been 89 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Additional Information

A significant number of our recently diagnosed COVID cases are school-aged children. We are encouraging those who can be vaccinated to do so in order to protect those in our community who may not be eligible.

As a reminder, all individuals age 16 and older are now eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. Moderna vaccine, which is authorized for those 18 years and older, is available to our community residents through the Cayuga County Health Department, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and pharmacies. However, 16 and 17 year olds can register for an appointment for the Pfizer vaccine at the Fairgrounds through the New York State Health Department website: <https://am-i-eligible.covid19vaccine.health.ny.gov/>
