Cayuga County Health Department will resume the use of the Johnson & Johnson (J&J) COVID-19 vaccine beginning this week after the Centers for Disease (CDC) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) lifted the pause on the vaccine on Friday, April 23, 2021.

The data shows that the benefits of receiving the J&J vaccine outweighs any potential risks associated with this vaccine.
