New Cases

Monday, August 9, 2021 – twenty two new cases completed

Tuesday, August 10, 2021 -twenty one new cases completed

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation

107 Mandatory Isolation

Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020

There have been 6,446 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Hospitalizations

There are 8 COVID-19 related hospitalizations at Auburn Community Hospital.

Deaths

There have been 91 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Additional Information

From August 1, 2021 – August 10, 2021 there have been 109 COVID cases. Of these cases, 75 were unvaccinated individuals. Of the unvaccinated, 44 are age 18-64 and 26 are cases under the age of 18. To provide context, the entire month of June had 45 cases and the entire month of July had 73 cases.

Recently there was a party, which has been linked to 12 cases that we are aware of, and there are believed to be more. In addition, there was a funeral involving two counties conducting contact tracing on residents who attended. We have five cases just in our county linked to the funeral.

The above two scenarios serve as a reminder that if you are not feeling well or have **any** symptoms of COVID-19, **please remain at home** as COVID-19 is highly contagious.

If you are experiencing any symptoms, seek healthcare to determine whether a test is warranted. If you are tested for COVID-19, self-isolate and await the results of your test.
