Cayuga County Health Department will be holding two walk-in vaccination clinics next week. The first will be held on Tuesday, August 3, 2021 from 2pm-3pm at the Port Byron Central School, 30 Maple Ave., Port Byron, NY, 13140. We will be offering Moderna, Pfizer, and the Johnson and Johnson vaccines.

The second clinic will be held Wednesday, August 4, 2021 from 1:30pm-2:30pm at Fingerlakes Mall, 1579 Clark St. Rd., Auburn, NY. Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be available at this clinic. Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
