## **Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 3:15pm**

### **New Cases**

Friday, August 20, 2021 – thirty-two new cases completed

Saturday, August 21, 2021 – twenty-three new cases completed

Sunday, August 22, 2021 – nine cases completed

### **Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation**

231 Mandatory Isolation

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 6,756 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Hospitalizations**

There are 5 COVID-19 related hospitalizations at Auburn Community Hospital. Two individuals in their 90's, one in their 60's and one in their 50's.

### **Deaths**

Two Cayuga County residents, a male in his 60's and a male in his 70's had tested positive for COVID-19, were hospitalized and have passed away. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and her family, we will not be releasing further information.

There have been 93 total Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

### **Additional Information**

Today, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration approved the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 disease in those 16 years of age and older. Pfizer continues to be available under emergency use authorization, including for those children 12 through 15 years of age.
