Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 5:00pm

New Cases

Monday, August 23, 2021

- 25 positive laboratory reports received through the New York State laboratory reporting system.
- 42 positive COVID cases who have had a complete investigation over the phone and were enrolled into Isolation.
 - This number can include individuals with at home COVID19 positive test kits or those who we may not have had contact with the day their laboratory report came through the reporting system. This is the data received through the New York State contact tracing system.
 - Of the 42 positive cases, 12 of these cases were vaccinated.

Tuesday, August 24, 2021 –

- 18 positive laboratory reports received through the New York State laboratory reporting system.
- 50 positive COVID cases who have had a complete investigation over the phone and were enrolled into Isolation.
 - This number can include individuals with at home COVID19 positive test kits or those who we may not have had contact with the day their laboratory report came through the reporting system. This is the data received through the New York State contact tracing system.
 - Of the 50 cases, 11 of these cases were vaccinated.
