### **New Cases**

Monday, September 27, 2021 - 48 new cases

- 29 unvaccinated, 19 vaccinated

### **Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020**

There have been 8,081 cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

The Cayuga County Health Department will be hosting a COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Saturday, October 2, 2021. REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED. To register for an appointment visit: [www.cayugacounty.us/health](http://www.cayugacounty.us/health)

The clinic will be held at the Fingerlakes mall from 10am – 12pm. Both first and second doses will be available. All three COVID-19 vaccines will be offered. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson are approved for those who are 18 years of age and older.

Children 12 years of age and older are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and a parent or guardian must accompany anyone under 18 years of age at this clinic.
