### **New Cases:**

Thursday, January 6, 2022 – 226 new cases

• 100 unvaccinated, 126 vaccinated

Active Cases in Mandatory Isolation: 776 in Mandatory Isolation

### Confirmed Cases – total since March 18, 2020:

There have been 12,837 cases of COVID-19 reported in Cayuga County.

**Total hospitalized cases: 18 Cayuga County residents** (11 of which are unvaccinated)

COVID-19 hospitalization reports received today from Crouse Hospital, Upstate University Hospital, St. Joseph's Health, and Auburn Community Hospital.
