I know the village is in the process of getting bids on different heating sources and I just wanted to give my input as a tenant of the building.

I would prefer the electric splits over fuel oil, kerosene or propane. Environmentally I have to jump through hoops with inspections and corrections to certify the tank to personnel in Washington DC at least once a month. Taking pictures, ordering labels that need to be applied and monthly inspections.

Our country has been going green environmentally and it gets harder and harder to keep these above ground storage tanks; eventually they will be depleted. The village will have the expense and the splits may cost a bit more for installation. However if you look into the future I believe it would be the best investment.

The cost of fuels have been outrageous. For one month the post office paid \$2600 to fill tank; this office has limited installation and it is hard to keep heat or air conditioning at a steady temperature.
