#23-16 from Robert Arleo for construction of a seawall at 281 Main St (Tax Map #182.17-1-5) – Sketch Plan Conference

Engineer, Andy Sciarabba, and stone mason, David Von Jess, described constructing a 2'-4.5' high seawall above the high-water mark on Dr. Arleo's property. Applications were submitted to the Army Corps of Engineers/NYSDEC for determination if a permit from their office is warranted. The project also includes stone steps to a stone terrace at the shoreline. The existing riprap will be reused as slope protection on each end of the seawall.

The Planning Board reviewed with the applicant the Site Plan Checklist in section 903 of the Village of Aurora Zoning Law for a clear understanding of what is required for the project review. Additionally, the Board discussed the following:

- Setbacks, specifically north and south where the boulders are located
- SEQR Unlisted or Type 2
- Cayuga County 239 Review
- Special Use Permit Public Hearing for excavation
- Drainage Plan
- Erosion Control Plan

• Consultation with the Village Engineer

On motion by Sheradin, seconded by Murphy, the Planning Board voted to schedule a site visit on July 17 and tentatively scheduled a public hearing for August 9, contingent upon SEQR and 239 review schedules.
