NY Forward: CNY REDC nominates 2 applicants for \$4.5 Million award each

Downtown Revitalization Initiative: CNY REDC nominates 1 applicant for \$10 Million award <u>Joint DRI applicants will share the award amongst communities</u>

• Community Characteristics: Small, Walkable, Strong Sense of Place

- **Project Types: Private & Public -** Building Renovation & Redevelopment, Activation of Upper Stories, Tourism & Employment Growth, Public Recreation & Cultural Site Enhancements, etc.
- Application shows the REDC what could be done- no commitments for projects or costs
- Post Award State Paid for Planning Process, Projects get firmed up, commitments made for project costs and match, Local Planning Committee (LPC) selects projects, report sent to State, Governor decides what gets funded






