On August 11, 2023 the Health Department conducted a routine inspection of the Wells College Dock Bathing Beach located at 456 Main Street, Aurora, NY. A copy of the inspection report was mailed to you.

During the course of the inspection one "red-letter" critical hazard violation was observed. A fine of up to \$2,000.00 for each violation can be assessed at a Board of Health hearing.

We offer you the opportunity to avoid attending a formal Board of Health hearing by accepting the enclosed Consent Order and returning it (signed and dated) by September 14, 2023.

I, the undersigned, as operator of the Village of Aurora Recreation Program (Wells College Dock Bathing Beach), Aurora NY do hereby admit that the following violation was found by the Health Department during a routine inspection on August 11, 2022. This is the first critical violation found at this facility in the past 3 years.

1. ***Signs Prohibiting Swimming When The Beach Is Closed Or Unsupervised (6-2.4(b)(8))***

Observed 2 patrons actively swimming in water unsupervised during inspection. No signage stating the bathing beach was closed was observed. Patrons were instructed to exit water. The bathing area was closed and signage indicating such was restored.

The violation has been corrected in that lifeguards returned to the site before patrons reentered the water and appropriate signage was posted at the facility.

I understand that by signing this Consent Order the Village of Aurora Recreation Program hereby waives any right to a Cayuga County Board of Health hearing regarding this violation.

The Health Department accepts this Consent Order in full satisfaction of the violation. No further action will be taken on this violation, although future violations that might occur will be subject to penalty. This violation is a matter of record and may be used in future enforcement actions to document a pattern of chronic or repeated violations.

This Consent Order will be presented to the Cayuga County Board of Health for adoption at its next routine meeting.
