Aurora, New York

The following is a list of houses, buildings, and portions thereof built in the 19th century which can be attributed to Samuel Mandell and his son Samuel D. Mandell. All dates and descriptions from Mandell, Samuel D. (with Leffingwell, Dr. Albert), "A History of the Houses in Aurora," except as noted.

5. 425 Main Street* Rear addition to this 1817 house designed and built by S.D. Mandell	Leddra Wood House addition	S.D. Mandell	1884
6. 413 Main Street Built in 1828 by Charles Campbell, remodeled by S.D. Mandell for E.W. Mosher; also known as James Avery House	Campbell/Mosher/Avery House	S.D. Mandell	1884
7. 405 Main Street Built by Samuel Mandell for Ephraim Marsh; remodeled by D.W. Armistead, circa 1900. Also known as Doc Burlington House.	Ephraim Marsh House	Samuel Mandell	1834
8. 396 Main Street*	Taylor House dining room	S.D. Mandell	1871

Henry Morgan House built 1838 by John Maurice, dining room added in 1871, designed by Russell Sturgis, NYC and built by S.D. Mandell

| | | Session House – Social Rm Presbyterian. Church | S.D. Mandell | 1848 |
| 13. | 336 Main Street | Old Captain Chase House | Samuel Mandell | 1848 |
| | Early portions of the current structure were rebuilt by Samuel Mandell in 1848. It was moved to current location from near E.B. Morgan House. | | | |
| 14. | 330 Main Street | Williams House | S.D. Mandell | 1850 |
| | Also known as Alfred King house | | | |
| 15. | 325 Main Street* | Masonic Lodge | | 1819 |
| | Samuel Mandell worked on the Lodge; but was not the lead builder. He used the first floor of the Lodge as a carpenter shop until 1838 when the Episcopal Church began holding services there. | | | |
| 16. | 320 Main Street | Episcopal Church | S.D. Mandell | 1871 |
| | Designed and built by S.D. Mandell | | | |
| 17. | 318 Main Street | Mandell House Barn | S.D. Mandell | 1884 |

| Main Building designed by William Henry Miller, constructed by S.D. Mandell to replace Wells Seminary Building which was designed and built by S.D. Mandell in 1868 and was destroyed by fire in 1888. | | | |
| 25. 19 Wells Rd* | Richmond House | Samuel Mandell | 1819-1820 |
| Built by Samuel Mandell and Richard Davis, subsequently moved to this location from the Henry A. Morgan property | | | |
