Display: “**St. Patrick’s Church at 150: A History in Pictures**” opened for the Bishop’s visit and gala sesquicentennial celebration on August 11. As of yesterday, almost fifty visitors had enjoyed the exhibit. The “Find Your Family” table was immediately popular, and the names of several previously-unidentified people in century-old photographs were added to the record. Original building plans, rare construction photographs, and information about the house of the first Mass in Aurora and St. Agnes’ Church intrigued guests. The Wall of Honor, with accompanying memoir and memorabilia, recognized parishioners who served. The show remains open Tuesdays, 4:30-6:00 pm, and Saturdays, 11:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. through early November.
