

The Cayuga County Veteran Service Advisory Board (CCVSAB) announces the Veteran Community Service Award for 2024.

This award will honor and recognize a United States Military Service Veteran that currently resides in Cayuga County, who has used their military experience to have a positive impact in their community since leaving military service.

To nominate a Veteran, submit a no more than 500-word outline that highlights the Veteran's military service, and civilian accomplishments. All work will be considered for review, but non-profit and volunteer work will be weighted for evaluation. How the Veteran demonstrates the qualities of being: Versatile, Experienced, Trusted, Energetic, Resilient, Astute, Noble, will also be assessed.

The selected Veteran will be recognized at a Veteran's Day Ceremony in their area; and \$500 will be donated to a non-profit organization that supports Veterans in Cayuga County, of their choice.
