

# How the Cayuga County Health Department Distributes Messaging to the Public



#### Call the Cayuga County Health Department at 315-253-1560.

- o During normal business hours, Monday–Friday, calls are answered by Health Department staff.
- o After hours (nights, weekends, holidays), calls are answered by an answering service who will direct calls to an appropriate staff member or take a message to be returned on the next business day.

- o This is a general email address for the public to send questions, concerns, and complaints.
- o Emails are forwarded to the appropriate Health Department staff member. A response is typically given within 1–3 business days.

## The Cayuga County Health Department encourages the public to sign up for the following notification platforms:

- <u>Hyper-Reach Emergency Alert Notifications</u> (page 2): Cayuga County E-911 Emergency Communications Department utilizes the Hyper-Reach system as a way of notifying the community of emergency situations. When necessary, the Cayuga County Health Department uses Hyper-Reach to directly communicate with members of the community, such as when a Boil Water Order is issued.
- <u>Health Department Notify Me Press Releases and Alerts</u> (pages 3–4): Notify Me is a Cayuga County system that allows the users to select which alerts, news, meetings, agendas, and other notifications they would like to receive. The Health Department utilizes this platform to distribute press releases and other alerts.

#### Sign up for Hyper-Reach Emergency Alert Notifications.

Mobile/Cellular phone numbers and email addresses must be registered with the Hyper-Reach notification system to receive the information. Landlines are already registered with Hyper-Reach.




# Sign up to receive automatic Health Department Notify Me Press Releases and Alerts.

- 2. Click the "Notify Me" button on the county's website to sign up for notifications from certain departments.




3. Enter your email address, click "Notify Me Sign In," and follow the prompts.

- o Press releases are distributed via email to the following:
  - 1. Local Media (e.g., Print, TV, Radio)
  - 2. Cayuga County Employees and Legislators
  - 3. Cayuga County Board of Health members and the Health Department Medical Director
- o Press releases are posted on the Cayuga County Health Department website, Facebook, and Instagram social media pages.
- O Depending on the topic of the press release, it may be distributed to city officials, town/village officials, schools, hospitals and healthcare facilities and other organizations.
- o If you do not receive press releases automatically, you must register for Notify Me on the Cayuga County website. Follow the steps on pages 3–4 of this document to do so.
