We've received 19 applications this year. 4 for new roofs, 4 for interior work, 7 for exterior work, 1 fireworks display, 1 minor subdivision and 1 fence permit. 15 were issued. The tent structure at 391 Main St. has completed a long approval process for the Inns of Aurora. This required a minor subdivision and approval from the CPP and Planning Board.

The recent 10-minute fireworks display at 391 Main St. had the proper permit. My apologies for the excessive noise. The company's material described the size of the shells, and I did not catch the fact that some were larger than the Village Law allows. This won't happen again.

We have a July court date for a violation of the Village Zoning Law which prohibits keeping commercial shipping containers on properties in the Village. They are sometimes allowed in conjunction with a building permit for a temporary period, but this one has been on a residential property for over 5 years.
