Over the last month I've met with Corey Guerrette to discuss some changes The Inns of Aurora want to make to the Village Market. They plan to change it into a breakfast/lunch type of café and sell some takeout food items. I received the plans on Monday the 9th. I reviewed the plans then set up a meeting with Jim Burkett, Corey, and myself on March 12 to go over the changes which will not immediately change anything on the outside of the building, so the CPP won't have to be involved.
