On Friday May 15th the Village received a formal written complaint regarding the Inns of Aurora blocking off all parking on both sides of Main Street near the Aurora Inn. This is a NYSDOT issue which Fire Chief JD Balloni quickly confirmed by contacting NYSDOT. A permit allowing this was not obtained by the Inns of Aurora.

I've been inspecting all ongoing projects in the Village, which include 15, 231, 385, and 513 Main Street, 50 Court Street, and 4 Lafayette Street,

I did Certificate of Occupancy inspections at 4 Lafayette Street and 385 Main Street. 4 Lafayette needs an electrical inspection to obtain a CO. 385 Main Street (Village Market) which meets all the code requirements, I believe that they expect it to be open on May 22nd or 23rd.

I received my Certificate of Completion from the New York Building Officials Conference Central Chapter for completing 24 hours of in-service training, 8 hours of Professional Development Electives, 3 hours of the Energy Conservation Construction Code, 5 hours of the Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code, 8 hours of Code Enforcement and Administration.

As a side note I have joined the Aurora Ledyard Historical Society.
