

May and June 2026

During May I continued monitoring outstanding building permit projects and closed out finished project files, I issued one certificate of completion at 50 Court Street. I'm going to do a Certificate of Occupancy inspection at 4 Lafayette Street tomorrow. The electrical inspection has been completed, and the carbon monoxide detectors have been installed.

I issued permits for 28 Cherry Ave to rebuild a porch, which was approved by Jim Burkett and for 513 Main Street for a small pool pavilion -18' x 14'. This property is not in the historic district,

Recently there has been a fire alarm issue at 311 Main Street. I've spoken with the Fire Chief JD Balloni and to Corey Guerrette of the Inns of Aurora, who own the property. I'm going to give permission to the monitoring company to program the smoke detector for a 3-minute delay before the alarm is triggered.

I received a call from a wedding planner in Rochester two weeks ago about having a fireworks display for a wedding at the Aurora Inn on July 4th. Fortunately for the Village there were no fireworks companies available, so it's not going to happen. I would like to request the Village Board to consider banning fireworks in the Village altogether. Fireworks can become problematic as everyone on the Village Board knows from past experiences.
