Community Preservation Panel September 2, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: Mr. Burkett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: On motion by Morehouse, seconded by Wendler, the CPP voted to approve the July 1, 2026 minutes.

Old Business: No Old Business was discussed.

New Business

Application #26-16 from Alan & Carolyn Connors for an addition at 34 Cherry Ave (Tax Map #182.13-1-16)

Ms. Connors described adding an addition of a bedroom and bathroom on the back of the house for handicap access.

Ms. Connors added that they may have to extend the driveway which could trigger a Special Use Permit for Excavation.

Mr. Wendler questioned the distance between the back yard and the cemetery and Ms. Connors replied that the Village Code Enforcement Officer confirmed that the project is well within the required setbacks.

The CPP reviewed the Part 1 Short Environmental Assessment Form (SEAF) submitted by the applicant.

On motion by Wendler, second by Blum the CPP voted to designate Application #26-16 a Type 2 Action requiring no further environmental review.

Application #26-20 from the Inns of Aurora for replacement windows at 431 Main Street (Tax Map #181.12-1-10)

Mr. Guerrette explained that not all the windows were replaced during the renovations in 2005, due to the expense. He described aluminum clad windows with matching trim.

Ms. Morehouse questioned if the glass can be salvaged and offered to check with Significant Elements in Ithaca. Mr. Guerrette said they will salvage if possible.

On motion by Rossmann, second by Morehouse, the CPP voted to deem Application #26-20 "Replacement in Kind" requiring no further CPP review.
