1. **WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the Village to adopt a local law imposing **up to a 12-month** moratorium on the filing, acceptance and/or, approval of Fireworks Permits within the Village of Aurora; and
2. **WHEREAS**, the action is a Type II action, and is not subject to SEQRA; and
3. **WHEREAS**, that the Village Board of the Village of Aurora held a properly noticed Public Hearing at the Village Municipal Building on September 23, 2026 at approximately 6:00 p.m. and gave due consideration to public comment on, Proposed Local Law #2 of 2026; and
4. **WHEREAS**, the Cayuga County Department of Planning and Economic Development for General Municipal Law §239(l) and (m) reviewed Local Law #2 of 2026 at meeting on September 17, 2026 and found that there are no intra-municipal impacts;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Aurora hereby enacts Local Law #2 of 2019
